He fought valiantly against two cancers. In 2010 he was diagnosed with multiple myeloma and in 2016 he was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. He underwent a rigorous treatment regimen, always with a positive attitude, which was an inspiration to all who knew him.

A graduate of Woodlawn High School and Auburn University, he received the Master of Arts Degree with a concentration in guidance and counseling from Troy State University. In 1970, he joined the U.S. Air Force and had an impressive military career with many awards and decorations. A Vietnam veteran, he retired from active duty as a Colonel in 2004.
