Anna Margaret Loftin Brown, 87, of Center Point / Trussville passed away after a battle with Alzheimer's on October 30, 2023.

Anna Margaret was born on February 3, 1936, in Huntsville, Alabama to Gordon Bartley Loftin and Constance Ward Loftin. She had a younger brother, Gordon Bartley Loftin, Jr. Anna Margaret graduated from Huntsville High School and then attended Howard College (Samford University) where she earned a degree in Education. She later earned a master's degree in education from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Anna Margaret's teaching career spanned thirty-eight years, the last thirty-four teaching 1st grade at Center Point Elementary. In retirement, she spent many years working with the children's ministry at First Baptist Church of Center Point.
