Cleveland "Eng" Owen, age 93, of Preston Island, Alabama passed away on Sunday, February 18, 2018. He was raised in Mt. Pleasant, Tennessee, one of 12 brothers and sisters. He was a veteran of World War II serving with the Marine Corp during the battle of Iwo Jima and the occupation of Japan. After the war, he graduated from the University of Tennessee as an Industrial Engineer. He then lived and worked overseas in Australia, Jamaica, Italy and Venezuela. He was preceded in death by his wife of 65 years, Lygia Saxon Owen; two sons, Frank and Bobby Owen; and several siblings.

He is survived by his two daughters, Lygia and Rebecca and five brothers and sisters; eight grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren and nieces, nephews and extended family members.
