Mr. Donald Reed Statham, 83, of Birmingham, AL passed away on August 6, 2024. He was born on June 30, 1941 to Leonard J. Statham and Edna Hanlon Statham. Donald attended Woodlawn High School (Class of 1959) and the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa. After serving 25 years, he retired as Director of Data Processing at Carraway Methodist Medical Center. He was a full time RV'r for 14 years, seeing all 50 states and most of Canada. 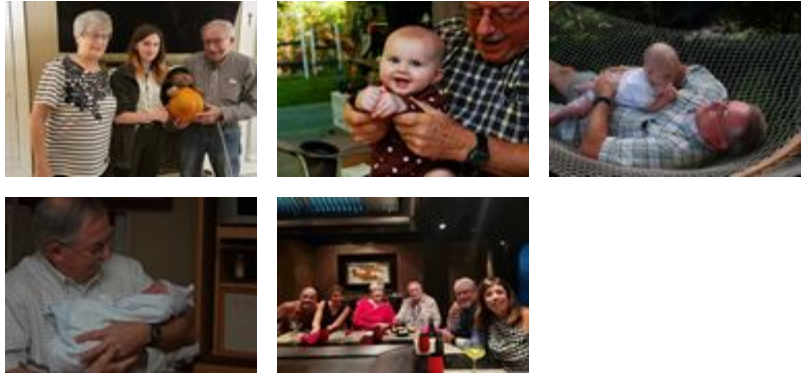
