Mr. Douglas W. Ingram died peacefully on January 21, in Irondale, Alabama, at the age of 74. While at Ole Miss, he played in a band called the Ole Miss Downbeats. Doug earned his M.B.A. at Mississippi College in 1973. In the late 1970s, he played in a successful band called Destiny. He married Carrie Jane King in 1977, and worked as a telephone engineer for BellSouth for 25 years. He retired from BellSouth in 1991, after completing his Juris Doctor degree at the

Birmingham School of Law to pursue his lifelong dream of practicing law. Doug was a devoted husband and father. He gave wise and patient counsel to his many clients. He was an avid guitarist, and was known for his incredible repertoire and singing voice. He also gardened and was proud of his homegrown tomatoes every summer. He was a lifelong Ole Miss fan, and faithfully cheered the Rebels every season. He was cheerful and funny; a friend to all. A memorial service is scheduled for Saturday, January 27, at 11:00 a.m., at Deerfoot Memorial Funeral Home in Trussville. The family will receive friends from 10 a.m. until service time. 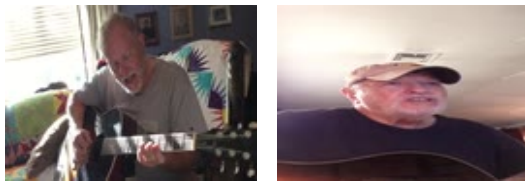

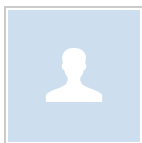

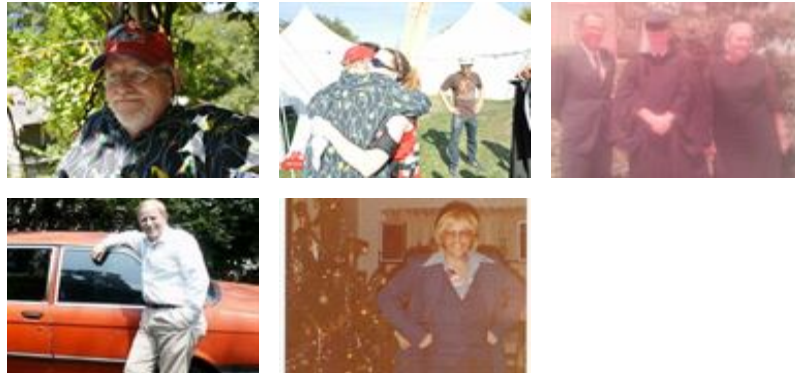
