A long-time, loyal employee who was loved and respected by his coworkers, George completed projects throughout the Southeast. George was a loving and patient father who was always there to help his children move houses, do projects or cut up their meat. His grandchildren loved him, first as Dani, a childhood nickname for Granddaddy that stuck for his older grandchildren and then solidly as Granddaddy to his younger grandchildren. He cheered on their accomplishments from taking first steps to riding a bike to first jobs and graduating from Marine Corps basic training. His pride in his children and his grandchildren was evident to everyone that knew him. of more than forty years, Rebecca, and the life that they built, starting in a small apartment in Birmingham before moving to Mississippi and returning to Alabama and settling in Clay to raise their children. 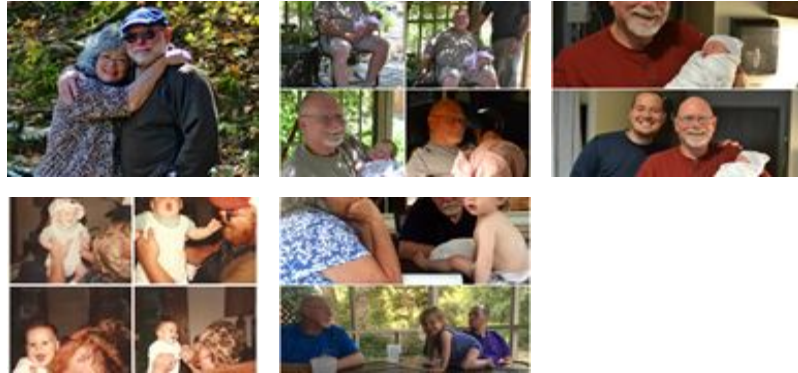
