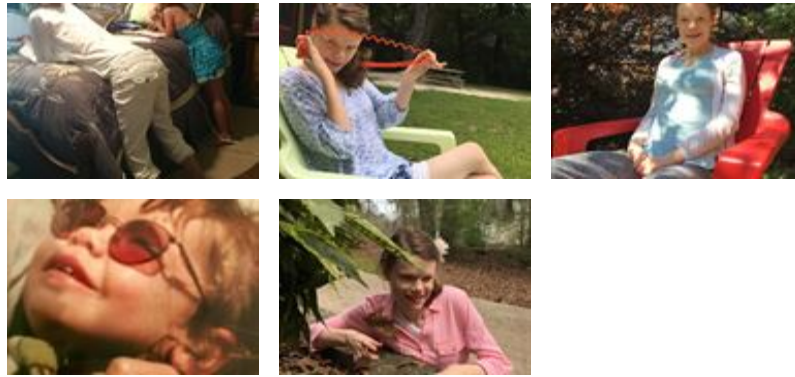

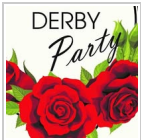
Hallie is a pure spirit who lived her earthly life loving, loved by, and cared for by human angels. She will be right at home in Heaven.

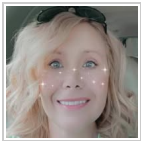
