



## Herbert Edgar Sherer

October 10, 1940 - November 22, 2020

Herbert (Herb) Edgar Sherer of Springville, AL., passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, November 22, 2020 surrounded by family. Herb was born in Tarrant, AL. and spent most of his childhood in the Inglenook area. Herb was self-employed, most notably in the dry cleaning and fast-food industries. Early on, Herb enjoyed Ham radio, Bluegrass music, Elvis recordings and was a fan of Alabama Football. Herb enjoyed music and could play several instruments including the guitar, banjo and piano, all by ear.
