I am heartbroken by his absence from me. I know he is no longer in the gut wrenching pain he's been in so long. His brow was smooth and the ravages of pain had left his blessed face.

Jay was a disabled Vietnam Veteran. His disabilities were the result of what was called Agent Orange, code name for the chemical dioxin poison, that was sprayed regularly over our young men and the country with which we were in a political "conflict" at the time only later to be called a war.

In the end, the poison destroyed Jay's body and he suffered in many ways for many years. His was a hard life. But, he loved me so completely and he loved our family fiercely. We had many, many happy years and times together. He was a survivor.

He would tell me he would have never made it without me. He said he would have been homeless. I have been told the same thing by his surviving brothers and others over the years. But, I'm here to tell you all, my Jay was a fighter and he did as well as he did because he wanted to be acceptable to

God and he wanted me to always know how deeply he loved me and our family. He was the catalyst of his survival. If he hadn't wanted to stand strong himself, there would have been nothing I could do to make him do so.

In the end, he was so tired. Today, he is rested, pain free, clear headed, can see colors, can dance, and most of all is united with God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit in person in Heaven. How I love him and long to be with him.
