Born to Clarence and Vera Fitzpatrick on June 15, 1938. Gary was an only child for almost 8 years and then his parents gave him 3 sisters, Beverly June, Judy Darlene and Carla Jane. He always said “life was good until those sisters came along”. Gary joined the United States Navy in March of 1955 where he was on a ship for most of his tenure with the Navy. He was designated to communicate with the other ships by using morse code through a light system. Gary met his future wife, Sue, in 1957 while they both were living in Beckley, West Virginia where after only two weeks of courtship he proposed to her and they got married shortly thereafter.

Gary was an active member of First Baptist Church of Center Point for over 60 years where he was an ordained deacon and also helped initiate the church’s first Bus Ministry that provided transportation to hundreds of children in and around the Center Point, Alabama area. He was a dedicated member and actively served in many capacities over his long-term church membership. Preceded in death by his parents, James Clarence Fitzpatrick, Vera Eulamae Peoples Fitzpatrick and son, James Thomas Fitzpatrick.
