John Arvel Crumpton, age 53, of Clay, formerly of Chalkville, AL passed away peacefully on Monday, December 2, 2024 at UAB-St. Vincents East Hospital.

John was born on March 30, 1971 at Carraway Hospital in Birmingham, AL. His chosen profession was in road construction where he was a heavy equipment operator for 15 years with Jefferson County Roads, Transportation and Environmental Services. He attended Chalkville Elementary School and Hewitt Trussville Jr. High and High School. He played little league baseball and football at Center Point Ball Park. He went on to play Jr. Varsity and Varsity football at Hewitt Trussville High School where he earned several awards including the Birmingham News Player of the Week and racking up a season high 1150 yards rushing. He had a special relationship with his football coach, Jack Wood. While in high school, he was also a member of the wrestling team. He was County Champion for the 9th grade County tournament. He wrestled in several tournaments where he won his matches to the delight of his family and friends.

John is preceded in death by his grandparents, Glenn and Edna Booth and Nelson and Cleo Crumpton.

He is survived by his parents, Arvel and Linda; sister, Amy Crumpton Moode; two sons, Jeffrey (Heather) and Johnathon (Candace); granddaughter, Lilly;

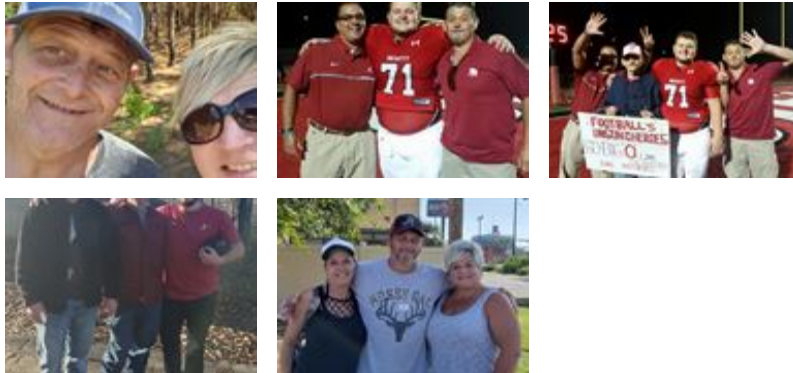
