Joseph Wayne Rumble, 90, of Trussville, Alabama, passed away peacefully on October 11, 2025.

Wayne was born on August 19, 1935, in Atlanta, Georgia, to the late Darden Rumble and Margaret Kell Rumble. Wayne was a loyal, hard-working, honest, loving, talented, and thoughtful man. He put his whole heart into every endeavor and truly believed that if you are going to do something, do it right. He was a man who could be counted on to keep his word and he expected much of himself. Wayne accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior when he was a teenager and was active in his church, even teaching Sunday school to children while attending Georgia Tech. Wayne and Julia lived in Georgia, Illinois, and Connecticut while their children were growing up. He always tried to be a good example to his children and give them opportunities to succeed. Later

after he retired, they moved to Asheville, North Carolina. After Julia passed away, he moved to Trussville in 2023. Wayne will be dearly missed, but we know that he is living in the presence of his Savior Jesus Christ in Heaven.

Wayne was preceded in death by his beloved wife of over 61 years, Julia Skelton Rumble, his son, Gregg Rumble, and brothers Ray Rumble and Henry Rumble. 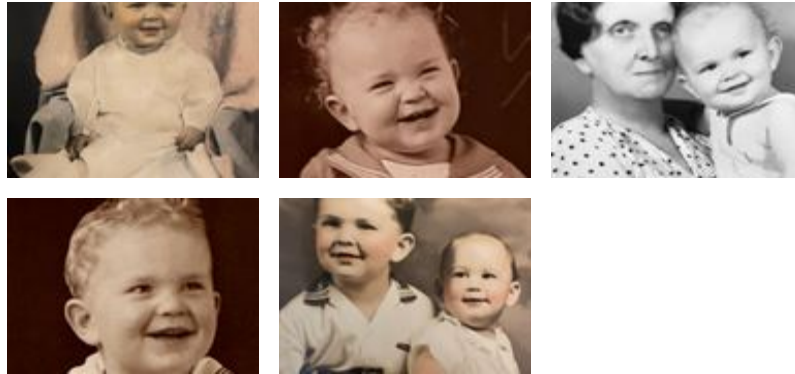
