



Junior Camillas Farmer

January 14, 1938 - August 9, 2022

Junior Camillas Farmer was born January 14, 1938 and passed away on August 9, 2022. He attended elementary school at Low Gap on Simmons Mountain then Jr. High at Pinson before graduating at St. Clair County High School. Junior attended several singing schools taught by his father which sparked an interest in quartet singing. At St. Clair County High School, he was a member of the award winning FFA Quartet. After high school he continued to sing in a local gospel quartet at churches and other venues. Early on he worked with his brother Cliff in his roofing business. He later began a career in excavating working on large projects including the building of Pinedale Lake and I-59 at Springville. He then started his own excavating business in partnership at first with his brother Cecil. Many lakes and ponds in St. Clair County were dug by them. In 1969 he opened Farmer Equipment Sales, specializing in refurbished heavy equipment and became a John Deere tractor dealer in 1991. He retired in 2008 but remained active until his health declined. Junior grew up poor where hard work was required daily. He believed that everyone could be successful if given an opportunity. As a result of this he was the poor man's friend and helped many along the way when in them he saw a glimpse of his own struggles.

Junior was preceded in death by his parents, Pinkney Farmer and Cora Coleman Farmer; brothers, Clifton Farmer and Cecil Farmer and by his sisters, Elsie Marshall, Lila Sutherland and Mary Shedd.

He is survived by his wife, Vickey Massey Farmer; children, Mickey Farmer
