Lara Kerrinnes, age 49, formally of Pinson, Alabama went to be with her Lord on Saturday, December 24, 2016.

Lara is the daughter of Bill and Rosemary Moffett being born in Birmingham, Alabama at Montclair Baptist Medical Hospital in 1967. She has three sisters; Lynn, Lisa and Leigh Ann, that together were raised in the Birmingham and Pinson areas of Jefferson County, Alabama.

Lara attended elementary, middle and high school in Jefferson County. Her extracurricular activities at Pinson High School included the color guard where she spent hot summers practicing her routines. Lara attended Jefferson State Community College, Birmingham, Alabama in the Survey program where she was enrolled in the civil design program. During her education at Jefferson State she was a teaching assistant for the computerized drawing program. Lara worked for the Southern Poverty Law Center contributing to their many projects by her hard work in the accounting department and assisting with special projects. Lara attended Kennesaw State University in the Finance program, achieving the standing of Junior. She was diagnosed with Bile Duct cancer in 2009 and was treated at Kennestone Hospital, Kennesaw, Georgia. After a brief remission the cancer reappeared in 2012.

The Kerrinnes's moved back home to Alabama in 2015 to be near the family, friends and places Lara grew up in. At the University of Alabama, Lara help the science of cancer treatment by participating in two experimental cancer treatments. Unfortunately treatment in Birmingham did not slow the

progression of her cancer which took her life on Christmas Eve.

Lara is survived by her husband of 19 years, Kim Kerrinnes, twelve year old son, Christian Kerrinnes, Father Bill Moffett, mother Rosemary Moffett, three sisters Lynn Tyler, Lisa Cooley and Leigh Ann Poe.

Funeral services and interment will be on Wednesday December 28, 2016 at 11:00am at the Trussville Cemetery on Gadsden Highway. The family will receive friends from 9:00AM to 10:00AM at the Deerfoot Memorial Funeral Home, Trussville, Alabama.
