Linda Eads was born in July of 1943 at East End Hospital in Birmingham, Alabama, the third child of Sid and Nell Kendrick (Richard & Barbara) She grew up in East Lake, attended

Robinson Elementary School, and later became a proud member of the very first graduating

class of the new Banks High School in 1961. In March 1962, Linda married the love of her life,

Neil Eads. Their first home was a small apartment behind a house on 87th Street and 5th

Avenue North in East Lake. Together, they welcomed three sons: Bryan (1963), Chad (1968), and Kevin (1971).

The family lived in several small homes around East Lake, always close to both sets of

grandparents. Though the house was small it was full of love, laughter, and adventure. Linda

worked at various jobs over the years, but her heart was always at home with her family.

Though they never had much in the way of material things, she and Neil made

sure their boys
never lacked anything they needed. As her sons often say, they didn't realize they had little,
because their home was overflowing with love, encouragement, and active grandparents who
were always nearby.

As wonderful as she was as a mother, her greatest role came in being "Nana" to her five
grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. She was the one her grandchildren always wanted
to be with, the one they loved to visit, and the one who made every gathering feel special.

Linda is survived by her husband of 63 years, Neil; her three sons, Bryan (Beth), Chad (Jamie),
and Kevin (Alicia); her five grandchildren, Taylor (Mallory), William (Courtney), Mason (Malorie),
Anthony, and Sydney Yarbrough (Luke); and four great-grandchildren. She is also survived by
her sister Barbara, extended family, and many lifelong friends who loved her dearly. She was
preceded in death by her parents, Sid and Nell Kendrick and her brother Richard (Bobbee).

Linda will be remembered for her selflessness, her devotion to her family, and the love she
poured into every role she held—daughter, sister, wife, mother, and Nana. Her family takes
comfort in knowing that she is now healed, whole, and rejoicing in the presence of her Savior,

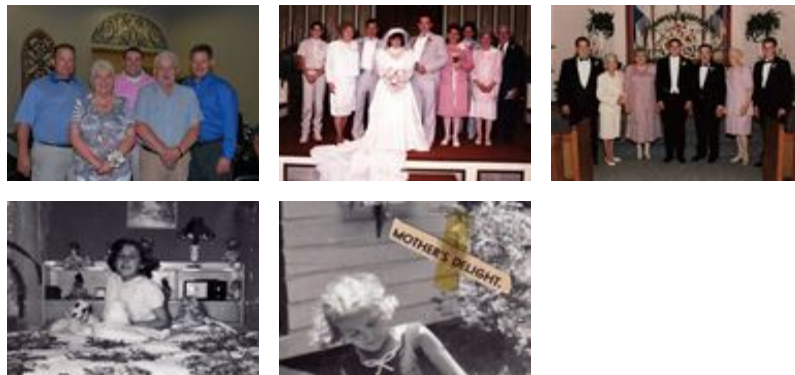
