Magdalene "Maggie" E. Tindill, 76, passed Dec. 28, 2019 in Birmingham, AL from complications of cancer. Born Oct. 2, 1943 in Lorraine, OH, Maggie graduated from Berlin Heights HS before meeting the love of her life, James Tindill Jr. They settled in Birmingham in 1981 where she began her career in advertising, working her way to media buyer, retiring from Intermark Group in June 2019. Remembered for her strong faith and caring nature, Maggie helped grow the Episcopal youth program "Happening" in the Diocese of Alabama, serving as "Big Sis" to hundreds of youth during her tenure.
