February 17, 1954 - December 7, 2024

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the sudden, but peaceful passing of Martha Boucher Lawler on Saturday, December 7, 2024 at her residence in Trussville, Alabama at the age of 70. Martha was a loving wife, mother, sister, grandmother, aunt, cousin and friend to all.

Martha was born in Portland, Maine at Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary on February 17, 1954 to Eugene and Nancy Boucher. She resided in Maine, Florida, and Alabama throughout her life making life long bonds and connections everywhere she went. Martha's nurturing spirit, unwavering support, and selfless giving nature will forever be imprinted in the minds and hearts of those who knew her and loved her.

Martha graduated from Deering High School in 1972 and was married to Michael Peter Lawler on May 25, 1974 at Woodfords Congregational Church in Portland, Maine. They gave birth to Jessica Ann Lawler on August 2, 1977 (born an angel), Andrew Michael Lawler in 1978, and Emily Kate Lawler in 1980 and moved to Florida in 1982 where Martha was a stay-at-home Mom. Once her children were teenagers, Martha worked in home and apartment

renovation and was especially gifted in drywalling. In Alabama she worked in retail at Home Depot in Crestwood and helped open the Trussville Home Depot store, working there for many years. She specialized in many departments including Hardware, Garden, Blinds, and many others. She was gifted in home decorating, painting, plumbing, and the list goes on. She called herself a “Jack of all trades and master of none”. Once her first grandchild Alex was born, she retired and became a caregiver to he and his sister Abby throughout all of their youngest years.

Her God given talent and ministry was in teaching the Word of God to young children. She faithfully volunteered at Cahaba Springs Presbyterian Church and Christ Church PCA in children’s ministry leading small children’s Sunday School for 17 years.

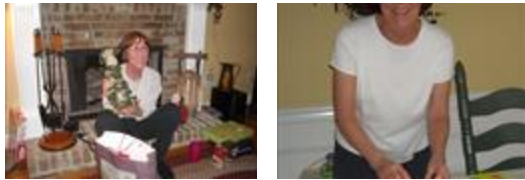
