Starting in 1995, Mary and Robert started traveling the country in their RV visiting over 40 states, and parts of Canada, but she limited trips to no more than six weeks so she could get back home to her family. She has been from the Atlantic to the Pacific coasts and the Gulf. Mary and Robert have been together for 77 years, meeting when they were 17, and marrying at 21. Mary taught Sunday School, was bereavement hostess (taking care of many of the meals herself), taught many VBS classes, PTA mom, and many other services. There is so much more to say about who Mary is and all that she gave and did. She was a founding member of Grace Bible Church in Center Point, AL. She is currently a member of Locust Fork Baptist Church in Locust Fork, AL.
