



## Mrs. Carl Annette Huffstutler

March 10, 1935 - August 17, 2024

Carl Annette Huffstutler, of Birmingham, Alabama was 89 at the time of her death. She passed Saturday, August 17, 2024 at 5:07 am.

Carl Annette was born March 10, 1935 in Tupelo, Mississippi to Ella Delphia and Joe Leon Dickerson. She had three sisters, Mary, Juanita, and Mae, and two brothers, Joe and Edward. She attended Rankin Elementary and graduated from Milam High School Class of 1953. She moved to Birmingham, Alabama in 1954 and went to work at Southeast Terminal.
