



Neil Jackson Sanders

May 28, 1938 - May 19, 2025

Neil Jackson Sanders, age 86, of Pinson, Alabama, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 19, 2025.

He was preceded in death by his parents Edward J. and Clara Goodwin Sanders and his sister Meredith Sanders.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Jo Salter Sanders; children, Susan Baker (Keith, dec.) and Neil Scott Sanders (Jerilynn); grandchildren, Jackson Baker, Elizabeth Baker, Darek Thompson, Justin Sanders, Caleb Sanders, Luke Sanders and Katie Sanders; his twin brother, Noel Sanders; a brother-in-law, sister-in-law, and numerous cousins, nieces and nephews.

Neil graduated from Hewitt Trussville High School and Jacksonville State University where he completed ROTC training. He served in the United States Army and Reserves where he achieved the rank of Captain. A family man who was loyal to a fault, Mr. Sanders grew up in Pinson, Alabama, where he left an enduring mark at his church, First Baptist Pinson, Alabama, in the community, and in the Jefferson County Beekeeper's Association. He was an avid Alabama and sports fan and was a long-time member of the Lions Club. As an employee of Alabama Power, Neil managed the Fuel Accounting Department until his retirement in 1998. After retiring, he was involved with the Energizers retiree group in which he served, as in everything he was involved, in

numerous positions.

Mr. Sanders funeral will be held at First Baptist Church of Pinson located at 4036 Spring Street Pinson, Alabama. The family will welcome visitors from 12:30 PM until the service time beginning at 2:00 PM. Dr. Kevin Sanders and Dr. Gary Fisher will be officiating. The graveside service will follow at Marvin's Chapel (located at Pinson Methodist Church).

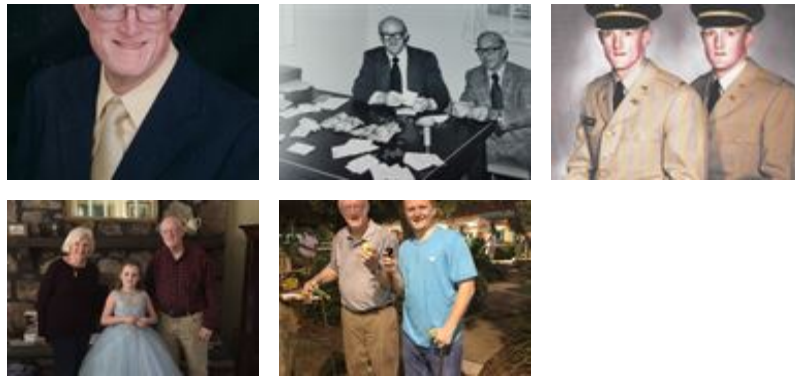
