Robert David ("Dave") Doyle was born in Rochester, PA on July 25, 1939 to Marcia & Robert Doyle. Dave passed away on January 25, 2021. There will be a small service for family only in Anniston on January 30th. Dave grew up in Slippery Rock, PA, and went to Grove City College, where he joined the ROTC. He served as a navigator in the Air Force during times of both conflict and peace. After serving in Vietnam, he was stationed for a time at Strategic Air Command Headquarters. He continued working with defense systems for his country when he left the Air Force to be a Civil Service Electrical Engineer with the Army, where he worked at Ft. McClellan in Anniston, AL - often traveling to the Pentagon. He also served in the Army Reserves. He married his wife Judith Walden ("Judy") on June 5, 1963 and they remained married for over 57 years. He was a resident in Anniston, AL until 2017, when he and his wife moved to Clay, AL. He was active for years in Anniston with the church choir and served many years as church clerk (First Baptist Church of Saks). He enjoyed working with Carpenters for Christ to help other churches in need. He also served many years on the board of Ft McClellan Credit Union. He is survived by his wife, Judy Doyle, his daughters Deanne (Thomas) Easterwood and Karen (Keith) Cunningham, 6 grandchildren: Ben Easterwood, Rebecca (Colin) Riggs, James Easterwood, Cassie Cunningham, Garrett Cunningham, and Hilary Cunningham, as well as two step-grandchildren: Ben Cunningham and Stephanie (Keith) Kent and their 4 children. He was a faithful Christian, husband, father, and grandfather and will
